#### **President's Message**



2017 continued to be a year of resolve. As our community continued to heal from the Pulse tragedy, we persevered in the face of adversity and uncertainty. We continued to make our voices be heard as our nation took steps backwards from supporting our transgender youth, servicemembers, and brothers and sisters. And we supported other communities as they healed from their own tragedies.

And in the face of these national and local heartbreaks, OYA continues to provide the resources and support for our Central Florida LGBTQ+ youth to thrive. We facilitated over 125 support group meetings throughout the year; hosted 24 Friday night drop-ins to provide a safe and social setting for youth to gather; supported 12 engaging events for our youth to celebrate themselves; provided grants to fund the creation and ongoing missions of six GSAs throughout greater Orlando; and provided six scholarships to LGBTQ+ youth to support their academic pursuits.

On behalf of our Board, volunteers, and over 100 Central Florida youth with whom who we have the privilege of working, thank you for your continued support as we pursue our mission to facilitate in the development of LGBTQ+ youth and provide a safe space for them to find the support they need to thrive.

#### Mission

The mission of the Orlando Youth Alliance and its chapters is to provide a safe space for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and questioning youth in Central Florida.

#### **Basic Overview of OYA**

The Orlando Youth Alliance has offered a weekly peer-to-peer support group for LGBTQ youth in Central Florida since 1990. Today, three weekly groups are offered: Orlando, Lakeland and Longwood. Monthly social, educational and recreational activities occur to further help our youth to develop a core group of friends and peer supporters. In addition to the support group and activities, OYA provides LGBT History & Culture classes, scholarships, career exploration and mental health referrals. Numerous professionals have spoken to our youth about their careers and the options that await them. Developing this nucleus of friends is the key to never feeling alone. Since LGTBQ youth are three times more likely to commit suicide than their heterosexual classmates, it is vital that we provide the services of OYA to our area youth.

#### The impact of OYA:

Over the past 27 years we have helped 1,600 youth and not a single one has committed suicide.


